Error 1015 Instructions for Bidding on Auctionzip

If there's error 1015 while trying to place a bid, below are some steps to help resolve it.

Use a different browser: Try switching to another browser such as Google Chrome, Firefox, Brave or Edge to see if it continues.

Try Incognito / Private Mode: Open your browser in Incognito Mode (Chrome) or Private Mode (other browsers). This can help bypass any cached data or browser settings causing the issue.

Following is for Google Chrome browsers.



Click on "New Incognito Window". Use Incognito Mode to go to website to bid.

Clear Your Cache and Cookies: Clearing your browser's cache and cookies can help fix any issues with outdated or conflicting content.



Launch the web browser you're using (Chrome, Firefox, Safari, etc.).

2. Access Settings or Tools:

- Chrome: Click the three dots (More) in the top right corner and select "More tools," then "Clear browsing data".

- Firefox: Click the three horizontal lines (Menu) and go to "Settings," then "Privacy & Security," then "Clear History".
- Safari: Click "Safari" in the menu bar, then "Preferences," then "Privacy," and finally "Clear Website Data".
- Other browsers: The process is similar; look for a "Settings," "Tools," or "Privacy" menu and navigate to the section for clearing browsing data or cache.

3. Choose Time Range:

Select the period for which you want to clear data. Options might include "Last hour," "Last 24 hours," "Past week," "All time," etc. @
